REPEAL *New 1099* **Requirements**

The Senate last month approved a measure to fully repeal a provision in the health care reform law that, beginning in 2012, will require businesses and nonprofits to fill out an IRS Form 1099 for every for-profit organization to which they pay at least \$600 for goods or services in a given year.

The House Ways and Means Committee subsequently approved similar legislation.

Consideration by the full House is expected the week of March 7.

The committee identified a total of nine issues as priorities, including sovereign immunity and privatizing; insurance; purchasing of state contracts; unemployment; sales tax exemptions; governance; zoning; and the economy.
